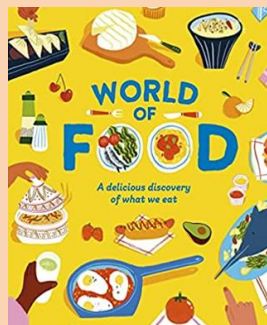

Bike safety is very important. Please see below for some bike/scooter safety tips.

Bike safety on the road

To reduce the risks to your child when cycling:

- they should always wear a helmet that fits
- they should wear reflective or high-vis clothing
- the bicycle's brakes, lights, reflectors, tyres and bell should be working
- the bicycle should be the right size for them
- they should not wear clothes that might get caught in the wheels or chain

Make sure your child knows how to cycle properly. They should be aware of the workings of the bike, such as the brakes and the chain.
